John and Rosina immigrated to the U.S. from Glückstal, South Russia in the spring of 1898. They originally homesteaded southwest of Wishek, North Dakota. In 1903, after proving up, they sold the homestead and bought a farm west of Hosmer, South Dakota, which was closer to Johann's siblings who had also settled in that area.

After the auction, John and Rosina retired to Hosmer. Their eldest son, Jacob, took over the farm.
