This book is a continuation of the history and information of our family concentrating on the Canadian Branch of our family.

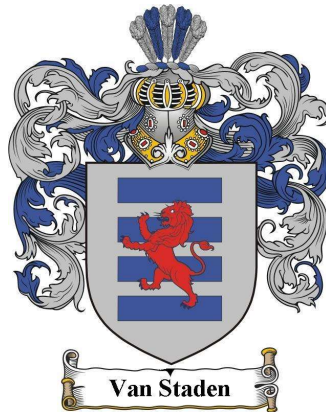

Inna Kast was a student at the Höheren Industrie Handelsschule in Odessa in 1943 and a copy of her photo that formed part of her studentcard dated 5/8/1943 is set out below.



On 17/8/1944 an entrycard (Ausweiskarte) was issued to her as she worked at the Mecklenburgische Metallwarenfabrik m.b.h. in Waren (Müritz) after she left home.

During this time the factory which was built during 1936/1937 was a subsidiary of Durerer Metallwerke and Bergman-Borsig Berlin which manufactured parts made of aluminium and duralumin as a supplier to the aircraft industry. The factory ceased production on 12/4/1945.

Her studies were stopped as she left to work in Mecklenburg. She left to Schleswig-Holstein and she earned income from doing casual work. In 1947 Inna Kast was registered as living in Glückstadt being a medical student

She applied to the South African Ambassador in Hamburg to go to South Africa and become a member of the Transvaal Medical Nurses Services.

In 1949, she was a student at Heidelberg University and she achieved a degree as a State Certified Translator

Her application to the Nurses Services was successful and she left for South Africa in 1950

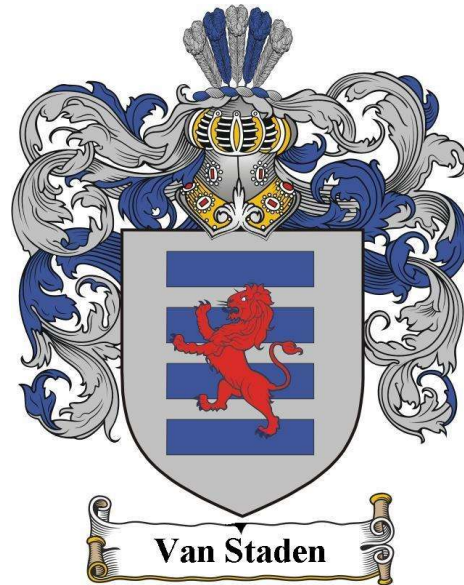

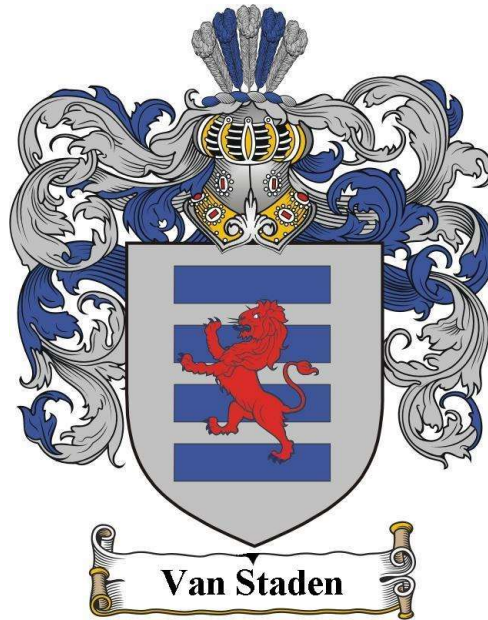
