* The ***Inovlatsky colonists*** were settlers near St. Petersburg from the town of ***Inovlac*** on the Pilice River in Prussian Poland who arrived there from Germany in 1809.

During this period, military operations were taking place in the area. The colonists, having suffered ruin, wanted to move to a quieter part Russia. They were settled in Russia on the lands of the Izvarsky, but the lands were not adapted for agriculture.

In 1811 after disturbances among the colonists, who were dissatisfied with their conditions, the Izvarsky colonists were again relocated; some closer to St. Petersburg, the rest were sent to the south, to the Novorossiysk Territory in 1812.
