November 22, 1910. We, signed below villager-proprietor from the village Wilhelmstal, municipality of Alexanderfeld, district of Odessa, governorate of Cherson, are owner of total 2090 ½ desjatins (1 desjatina = ca. 1,1 ha) and 51 farms and were invited to villager gathering by our village chief Philipp Walker, son of Bernhard. 35 persons with a right of vote were present. According to art. 51 and 52 of farmer agreement this is a legal adequate quantity for a villager gathering. Agenda: Budget planning for the next 1911 year.

Farmers who live temporary in Wilhelmstal have to pay 5 rubles for each cow and horse, and 50 kopeck for each calf and swine in the community coffer. Based on that we sign:
